Circulation Policy

Any church member or non-church member with a permanent address who signs a membership card may have the privilege of checking items out of the Library Media Center. Membership cards for children should be signed by a parent or guardian. The loan period for all items is two weeks. Adult members may check out 8 books per person, juvenile/children 4 books per person. Videos, DVDs, CDs, 2 per person with a maximum number of 8 per family.

Media may be renewed one or more times as requested unless the item has been reserved by another member. Renewals may be made by telephone or in person. Extended time may be granted on request for media study sets.

No late fees are charged for overdue materials, but we do feel that your promptness in returning borrowed items on time is a component of good stewardship. We ask also that you help us with re-stocking any lost or damaged items, including the clear plastic video or DVD cases.
